- Labor Day's origins began over a century ago in New York City at the height of the industrial revolution, when the average American worked 12-hour days, seven days a week in order to eke out a basic living in unsafe working conditions.
- The Knights of Labor initiated the day in 1882 as a celebration of the American factory workers.
- The Knights of Labor, founded by nine Philadelphia tailors in 1869, was one of the most powerful labor organizations of the 19th century.
- The Knights of Labor demanded an end to child labor, equal pay for women, and an eight -hour-work day through unionism.
- Membership in the Knights of Labor was open to all wage earners, except doctors, lawyers, bankers, traders, and manufacturers of liquor.

As we enjoy our long weekend, let us take time to appreciate the benefits we have today because of the early Labor movements and the contributions workers have made to the power and prosperity of our great country.

Case of the Month-Good things come to those who wait...

A few years ago, our client, a 31 year-old man from Old Town, went to the store to buy some chips and soda in his pick-up truck on a two-lane road around 11:30 p.m. When driving around a curve, another vehicle was in his lane and heading right for him. Our client took evasive actions by veering to the left to avoid the oncoming car. Unfortunately, the car in the wrong lane struck the bed of our client's pick-up truck on the passenger side. The impact was so severe that it tore the cargo bed off the truck.

Our client was transported by ambulance to the hospital, treated, and released. He continued working over the following year, but in extreme pain. He finally underwent lumbar fusion surgery. Unfortunately, he continued experiencing severe pain and was eventually diagnosed with failed back syndrome. Our client was never able to return to work after his surgery.

Due to our thorough investigation and interviewing several eye witnesses we were able to prove that the other driver, although never formally charged by the police, was intoxicated at the time of the accident.

The settlement result? Despite our client having a long history of back problems, we obtained an \$850,000 settlement for him after intense negotiations with the other driver's two insurance companies.

This case took nearly two years to settle because we advised our client to wait until he had reached, or came close to reaching, maximum medical improvement (MMI) before settling his case. MMI indicates that the injuries have stabilized and are more than likely permanent even with continued medical treatment. Because of this, our expert witnesses were able to more accurately evaluate the extent, cost, consequences, and impact of our client's injuries on his life.

Moral of the Story: Even though it is important to wait until injuries are stabilized after a serious accident before settling with the insurance company, **it is still vitally important to seek legal assistance immediately after a serious accident before witnesses and other valuable evidence are no longer available.**

According to the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (FDHSMV), Florida drivers illegally pass school buses nearly two million times each year!


Each illegal pass-by could result in a tragic injury or fatality of a student.

Knowing when to stop for a school bus can be confusing. These diagrams from FDHSMV help clear up the confusion.




