Safety Reminder—3 basic rules of ATV use

All-Terrain-Vehicles (ATVs) are recreational vehicles and must be used in a legal and responsible manner. Here are three important laws pertaining to ATV use in Florida:

- 1. ATVs cannot be operated on a public road, street, or highway. However, ATVs are allowed on an unpaved public roadway where the speed limit is less than 35 mph and only during the daytime.
- 2. An ATV driver under 16 years of age must be supervised by a licensed driver, wear a helmet and eye protection, and pass a safety course.
- 3. The operation of any vehicle with a blood alcohol concentration of .08% or more is illegal.

10 ways to protect children from attractive nuisances



Attractive nuisances can lead to death or serious injury and leave you liable. While every situation is unique, we suggest using common sense to keep children safe and eliminating obvious dangers that pose risks.

Here are ten "child proofing" ideas to protect Florida's children and yourself:

- 1. Install safety devices, like a fence, around a pool, hot tub, or other body of water.
- 2. **Post warning signs** that a child is likely to understand.
- 3. **Remove** rafts, inflatable toys, and other attractive objects from a pool or hot tub.
- 4. **Fence in** or secure yard machinery, a lawn mower, or other yard equipment.
- 5. **Clear out** or fence in excess junk, clutter, or wires from the yard.
- 6. **Secure, fence, or lock up** unguarded vacant buildings or structures.
- 7. **Clean up and secure** construction materials, tools, and equipment when building or renovating a house or at other building sites.
- 8. **Protect** children from piles of wood, lumber, and construction materials.
- 9. Properly dispose of refrigerators, iceboxes, washing machines, dryers, and other airtight household appliance.
- 10. Supervise children.






