

The first night of our visit was scheduled to be a beautiful dinner with many top-ranking officials from MDA,

however, only a few were able to attend because Hamas was shooting missiles into Israel and everyone was taking care of business. Those officers in attendance during dinner were constantly on their cell phones getting alerts and giving out orders. Even though we were not near the high danger zone near the southern border, we were given instructions regarding what to do if a red alert siren sounded where we were staying just north of Tel Aviv. I went out on the balcony of our hotel room and witnessed an Iron Dome missile intercept a Hamas rocket. The all clear was sounded at 4:30 A.M. that night and everyone went back to their normal lives as though nothing had happened. Even though I feel safer in Israel than in most places in the United States, I am ever hopeful that a lasting peace can be achieved, and that Israelis can live without the constant threats from the Arab terrorists.

The next day I had drinks with the creator of the Netflix series Fauda, Avi Issacharoff, on our roof-top pool deck. What an inspiring story teller! I highly recommend this riveting series explaining the complexities of the Israeli-Arab conflict.

Our group was given a special narrated tour at the Golan Heights by a retired army colonial who currently works to build relationships between Israelis' and Arabs. We were just a few yards away from the site of the 1973 Yom Kippur War battle known as the Valley of Tears Battle. Although massively outnumbered, the Israeli forces managed to hold their positions and on the fourth day of battle the Syrians withdrew just as the Israeli defenses were almost to the

point of collapse. Our tour guide told us a moving story about the Israeli tank commander giving a dramatic speech to his forces to keep fighting to save the State of Israel even though defeat seemed imminent.

The Director of the Magen David Adom blood bank, Professor/MD Eilat Shinar, gave our group an up close and personal tour of the main blood bank facility in central Israel and we toured the construction site for the new state of the art \$200 million-dollar underground blood bank being built not far away that will protect against missile strikes and earthquakes.

Our trip to Jerusalem included an emotional visit to the second Holiest site in Judaism, the Western Wall or Kotel. The Holiest site in Judaism is the Temple Mount above the Wailing Wall which is where the Second Temple was located until it was destroyed by the Romans in 70 CE. That site is currently occupied by the Muslim "Dome of the Rock" built at the end of the 7th

century. The Clash of Civilizations is nowhere more evident than in the Holy City of Jerusalem.
