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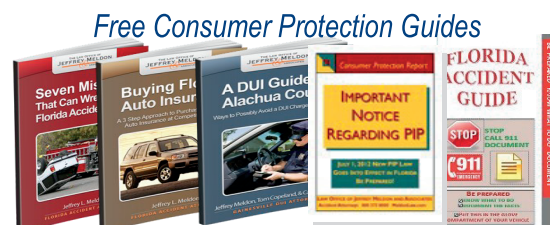

**Stefany's Quick Chocolate Cake in a Mug - Perfect for that late night craving!**

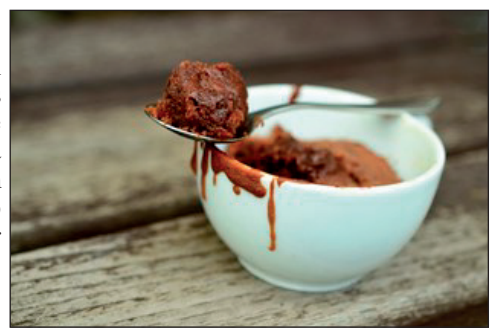
**Ingredients:**

- 3 Tablespoons All-Purpose Flour
- 3 Tablespoons Sugar
- 2 Tablespoons Cocoa Powder
- 1/4 Teaspoon Baking Powder
- Pinch of Salt (Optional)
- 3 Tablespoons Milk
- 3 Tablespoons Vegetable Oil
- Splash of Vanilla Extract
- 3 Tablespoons Chocolate Chips

**Directions:**

You will need a 12-ounce microwave safe ceramic mug and a microwave. Combine the flour, sugar, cocoa, baking powder and salt in the mug. Blend thoroughly with a fork. Add the milk, vegetable oil and vanilla and blend until smooth. Make sure to scrape everything from the bottom and sides. Stir in the chocolate chips.

Microwave on high for 1 minute 50 seconds. Let cool 2-3 minutes. The cake is very hot for the first couple of minutes. You can add a dollop of vanilla ice cream and drizzle chocolate syrup on top for an even sweeter treat!
