5 Things To Do To Recover From A Hurricane

Florida suffered the most catastrophic Hurricane ever (in terms of property damage) during the beginning of Sept 2017. Thank goodness we had relatively few lives lost and there were not too many serious injuries. However if you had damage to your home and car, lost power, couldn't get gas for you car or generator (if you were lucky enough to have one) then you may still be dealing with the high cost and inconvenience caused by Hurricane Irma. I recently spoke to a Public Insurance Adjuster (they help homeowners and business owners get fairly compensated from the insurance company) and he told me he may have two years of work just from Irma.

WHAT TO DO:

- 1. Take pictures of any damage to you home, car or other property you own.
- 2. Get out all of you insurance policies and see what kind of coverage you have(or just call your insurance agent and have them tell you)
- 3. Call your homeowners or auto insurance company and make a claim. If you don't have flood insurance call FEMA and see what they can do to help. You may also be entitled to defer payments on your home mortgage and/or car payments.
- **4.** Mitigate your damages by getting your valuables to a safe place and get a restoration company out to your home asap to clean up the water, etc. and prevent mold and other problems from complicating an already bad situation.
- 5. If you have substantial damage hire a Public Insurance Adjuster to present your claim to your insurance company.

The Public Insurance Adjuster fees are usually 10-15% of the amount recovered however they will probably get you double what you could get on your own. Florida Hurricane insurance coverage can be complicated. You have to deal with

Homeowner's Insurance with all kinds of "riders" including Wind Coverage, Flood Insurance, Auto Insurance, and Government Assistance. I recommend Joey Sharkey who has handled several casualty losses for property I own. You can reach Joey by phone at 352-246-3096 or by going to his website, sharkeypia.com. Just tell him Jeffrey said to call. Good luck to all of our friends in your recovery from this monumental Hurricane.

Recipe of the Month: Buffalo Chicken Mac and Cheese

Ingredients:

- -1 (16 ounce) package elbow macaroni
- -1 rotisserie-roasted chicken
- -6 tablespoons butter
- -6 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- -3 cups milk
- -1 pinch ground black pepper
- -2 cups shredded Cheddar cheese
- -2 cups shredded Monterey Jack Cheese
- -1/2 cup hot sauce
- -1/2 cup crumbled gorgonzola cheese
- -3 cups milk

irections.

- 1. Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Cook macaroni in the boiling water, stirring occasionally until tender yet firm to the bite, 8 minutes. Drain.
- 2. Cut wings and legs off rotisserie chicken. Skin and bone wings and legs; chop or shred dark meat into bite-size pieces.
- 3. Melt butter in a large Dutch oven over medium heat. Whisk in flour gradually until a thick paste forms. Cook until golden, about 1 minute. Pour in milk, whisking constantly, until thickened and bubbling, about 5 minutes. Continue to cook until sauce is smooth, about 1 minute more. Reduce heat and season sauce with black pepper.
- 4. Stir Cheddar and Monterey Jack cheese into the sauce until melted and combined. Stir in hot sauce, adjusting to reach desired level of spiciness. Add blue cheese, chicken, and macaroni; mix well to combine.

This month's topic of interest: October 2017

Each month our staff takes a number of calls from people within the North Central Florida Community. We use our clients' comments to come up with ideas for the topics of interest.

Here's a topic worth discussing.

School Bus Safety in Florida

What can't you do?

As most of you probably already know, when a school bus indicates that it will be making a stop it signals using the flashing stop signs that come out on the sides. When the bus does come to a complete stop you are required by law to come to a complete stop behind it. (FL Statute 316.172) It is crucial to also note that you cannot pass the school bus until the stop signals have been fully withdrawn. It is important to comply with this law for your own safety, and for the safety of the children entering or exiting the bus. Like running a red light, if you get pulled over by law enforcement for illegally passing a stopped school bus you are required to attend a mandatory court hearing as well as being required to potentially pay a fine or take a class or both, on top of receiving points on your license. A few points on your driver's license is not the end of the world, however it can increase your insurance premium tremendously, especially for younger drivers. It is important to remember when driving to slow down and pay attention to your surroundings to avoid being penalized for a moving violation or injuring a pedestrian or child which can lead to a more serious offense.

What can you do?

There is only one scenario in which you are allowed to pass a school bus and that is when you are on a divided highway separated from the school bus by an unpaved space of at least five feet, by a raised median, or a physical barrier.

Tips for Staying Safe and Avoiding Tickets

- Put Phones Away
- Scan Surroundings
- Refresh Yourself on Driving Rules and Traffic Control Signals and Signs

Did you know?

Did you know, that in the wake of Hurricane Irma, many residents were left without power, and in some cases, this caused street lights to be out as well. An important situational traffic rule to remember, especially for Floridians, is that when a street light is down at an intersection, the intersection is treated as a four way stop. There was a large increase in accidents after this hurricane because many drivers on the road were unaware of this rule and it caused severe and sometimes deadly collisions to occur.
