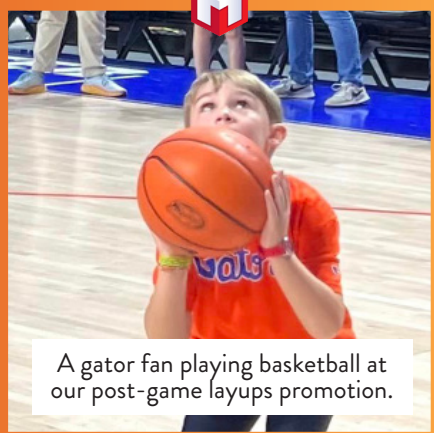

RECIPE OF THE MONTH - JOSH'S MINI EGG EASTER COOKIES

INGREDIENTS:

- 1/2 cup unsalted butter
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/3 cup light brown sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 1/2 cup flour
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1/2 tsp baking soda
- 1 cup mini chocolate eggs
- 1/2 cup chocolate chips



DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 350° Fahrenheit.
2. Cream together butter, sugar, and brown sugar.
3. Add vanilla and egg until incorporated.
4. In a separate bowl whisk together flour, salt, and baking soda.
5. Add in chocolate chips and mini chocolate eggs.
6. Roll the dough into evenly sized balls and place on a cookie sheet .
7. Bake for 10-12 minutes.
8. Cool on a baking rack and enjoy!
