RECIPE OF THE MONTH - ANGEL'S LOW CARB HAM, EGG, & CHEESE CUPS

INGREDIENTS:

- Cooking spray, for pan
- 12 slices of ham
- 100g grated cheddar
- 12 large eggs (from my own hens)
- Salt & pepper to taste
- Chopped fresh parsley, for garnish
- Optional: Cayenne Pepper



DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 200°C and grease a 12-cup muffin tin with cooking spray.
2. Line each cup with a slice of ham and sprinkle with cheddar.
3. Crack an egg into each ham cup and season with salt and pepper.
4. Bake until eggs are cooked through, 12 to 15 minutes (depending on how runny you like your yolks).
5. Garnish with parsley (sprinkle optional cayenne pepper) and serve.
