RECIPE OF THE MONTH - ANGEL'S SPANISH RICE

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 11/2 cups jasmine rice
- 3 cups water
- 2 roma tomatoes, chopped
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 3/4 cup fresh cilantro, or more to taste
- 1 tablespoon tomato boullion with chicken flavor(such as Knorr ®)



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Rinse the rice.
- 2. Place a pot over medium-heat heat; add oil and heat until oil shimmers slightly. Pour rice into hot oil, stirring constantly, until rice is golden to dark brown, about 5 minutes.
- 3. Mix water, tomatoes, onion, cilantro, and bouillon into rice. Bring to a boil and wait until you can see the top of the rice. Cover the pot tightly with a lid and lower the heat to very low and cook for about 20 minutes (stirring as needed and add a little of water if needed to prevent sticking to the pan). Adjust seasonings as needed.
